## **What to Expect**

**Board Size:** Up to 15 members. The Board may consist of up to five (5) appointed members from partner agencies and the remaining members are elected at the AGM. From time to time we may fill vacancies during the year.

# Board Term: 2 years

### Responsibilities:

- Policy Formulation: Establish policies to provide guidance to those empowered with the responsibility to lead and manage operations;
- *Decision-Making*: On matters that specifically require Board approval, choose from alternatives that are consistent with Board policies and that are in the best interest of the Corporation;
- Oversight: Monitor and assess organizational processes and outcomes.
- We also encourage participation in fundraising activities and community engagement.

Board of Directors are required to be members of CHEP and committed to the <u>mission</u>, <u>vision</u>, <u>and values</u> of the organization.
